heat (ஹீட்) (n.) hotness, வெப்பம்; சூடு.

heaven (ஹெவன்) (n.) home of God and the saints, சார்க்கம்.

◆May her soul rest in **Heaven**.



habit (ஹாபிட்) (n.) settled practice; ordinary or customary, வழக்கம்; பழக்கம்.

•He has the **habit** of getting up late.

hair (ஹெய்அ(i)) (n.) any or all of the fine filaments growing from the skin, மயி; முடி.

•She has the most beautiful hair I've ever seen.

half (ஹாஃப்) (n.) one of two equal parts, பாதி. •Pay half now and the rest later.

hand (ஹான்ட்) (n.) part of the human arm beyond the wrist. கை.

◆Your **hands** are dirty, go and wash them.

handicap (ஹான்டிகாப்) (n.) anything likely to lessen one's chance of success; disadvantage, தடை; தடங்கல்.

◆Poor eyesight is a **handicap** to a student.

• **Hitch** the ox to the cart.

hold (ஹோல்ட்) (v.) have and keep fast, பிடி; தாங்கு.

•The little boy was **holding** his father's hand.

hollow (ഇന്റെന്നെ) (adj.) not solid; having an empty space, குழிவான; உட்குழிவுள்ள.

◆This tree has a hollow trunk.

holy (ஹோ (adj.) of God; associated with God or with religion, புனிதமான; பரிசுத்தமான.

◆The Bhagvad Gita is a **holy** book.

•Today's young people give me **hope** for the future.

•The town was surrounded by **hostile** troops.

◆I will never come, **however** hard you persuade me.
