**judgement** (ஜட்ஜ்மென்ட்) (**n.**) the result of judging, தீர்ப்பு.

◆The judge gave a fair judgement.

**jump** (ஜம்ப்) (v.) to leap or spring, குதி.


He jumped up and down in excitement.

◆Her **jewels** were kept in the locker.

jittery (ஜீட்டர்)(adv.) nervous, பதட்டப்படுகிற.

•He was **jittery** when his boss called him.
