

- Ignorance of skills, earnings and potentials

# **SCENARIO TODAY**

- Drop-out rate between KG to Class 10+2 is 90% to 93%
- 'License Raj' in Higher & Technical education, restricting growth, R&D, quality and capacity.
- Cash out-flow of about US\$10 billion per year for Indian students leaving India for foreign Universities, because of lack of seats and quality education within India.

# **SCENARIO TODAY**

- These funds enough to build 40 IIM's & 20 IIT's per year!
- It is estimated that about 120,000 students leave every year for foreign studies.
- 50% opt for a two year Masters course and the balance 50% for a four year Under Graduate course.
- Functional Literacy expected to be about 33% against Government's figure of about 64%, but China is close to 93%
- Gaps in Skills development- Hardly 0.50% of the working population covered at any given time versus required 7%, as in China and other countries.

### Module A

- Activities and facilities and their study places
- Disseminate educational information for the use of students
- Hold orientation courses for the benefit of students passing out of the university
- Help in the total development of the students
- Help in the proper choice of furthering their education
- Help in the proper choice of career
- Help the students in vocational development

- Develop readiness for choices and changes to face new challenges

### Module B

- Develop in the students a broad and realistic view of lives, opportunities and problems at all levels of training
- Create awareness need and an active desire for accurate and valid occupational, educational, personal and social information
- Assist in learning the techniques of obtaining and interpreting information for progressive self directives

- Promote attitude and habits which will assist in the making of choices and adjustments protective of personal satisfaction and effectiveness
- Provide assistance in narrowing choices progressively to specific activities, which are approximate to aptitudes, abilities and interests manifested and to their proximity to defined decisions
- Make his/her own decisions and plans on the basis of self understanding, accept responsibility for the decision and take actions on plans developed
- Proper choice of co-curricular activities available in college/university
- The choice of job oriented course
- Getting Part time jobs during working sessions and full time jobs after getting education and training

### Module C

- Demonstrate concern and respect for the abilities and ambitions of each of his/her advisers and thus create a sense of belongingness in the student
- Explain the general programme of curricular and extra curricular activities to the advisors
- Help in the General Orientation Programme
- Encourage cultural interests which will help students integrate their studies and new vocational, cultural and recreational interests and activities
- Help by listening, by suggesting certain ideas and by working individually with students or if needed in groups
- Refer students with more difficult problems to the counselling centre or to other guidance facilities in I.N.D.I.A. TRUST
