We are looking to work to develop and produce modules that will be made accessible via our learning management system specially created for Chennai Schools' boys and girls.

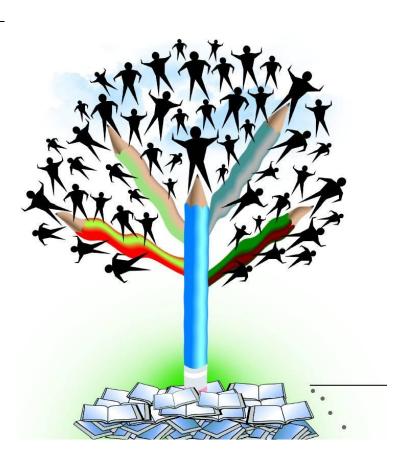

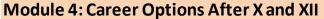

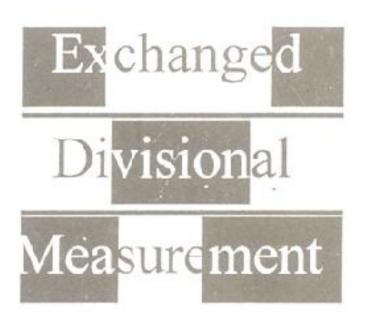

SYSTEM AND PROCESSES RECOMMENDED BY I.N.D.I.A. TRUST

Step 1:

Meeting individual school Headmasters and leaving with them the required number of questionnaires which should be distributed to the students and have to be completed before the commencement of public examination

Step 2:

The completed forms will be collected by our organization from the School principals before the prescribed dates (Tentatively scheduled before the end of this month for the +2 students and subsequently for the 10th standard students after the completion of their public exam)

Step 3:

Our organisation will analyse the questionnaires and will form various clusters depending on students' career preferences.

Cluster I:	ENGINEERING AND ALLIED COURSES
Cluster 2:	GENERAL SCIENCE
Cluster 3:	COMMERCE, LAW AND MANAGEMENT
Cluster 4:	GENERAL ARTS
Cluster 5:	MEDICINE, PARAMEDICAL AND ALLIED COURSES
Cluster 6:	GOVERNMENT JOB, SERVICE EXAMINATIONS
Cluster 6:	GOVERNMENT JOB, SERVICE EXAMINATIONS MILITARY AND POLICE
Cluster 7:	MILITARY AND POLICE

Step 4:

Based on the cluster formation, identical groups will be formed with each group constituting average 100 students either belonging to the same school or school situated in and around neighbourhood areas.

Step 5:

A team of Trainers and Career Counsellors from our organisations will be deployed to reach all schools (either to individual institutions or to the group of schools depending upon the cluster and group formation to Conduct Career Counseling and Training Workshops supported with multimedia presentation)

Step 6:

The duration of the training work shop will be for 10 hours spread over three sessions which can be completed within the span of 15 to 30 days.

Step 7:

Each student will receive specific knowledge inputs based on his/her choice according to the cluster. The output of the training will be to help the individual student to identify suitable career to his/her life and also to help him to create a road map to achieve it.

Step 8: Training Inputs:

Information about various career options and institutions providing them (For Higher Studies/ Employment/Self Employment/Vocational Courses):

- Personality Development.
- Examination preparation skills
- Communication Skill Development.
- Overcoming Inferiority Complex.
- Self Management and Self Motivation Skills.
- Managing Poor Self Esteem, Shyness, Stress.
- Complete guidance to connect learning with living.

Step 9: Certificate:

After the completion of Training and Workshops, the students can be given a certificate of Proficiency in Career Management.

Step 10: Feedback:

 $Periodical feedback \ will be obtained \ for \ assessment \ and \ appraisal \ right from \ the \ learning \ till \ students \ reach \ their \ career \ destination.$



FEATURES OF THE TRAINING

Asynchronous learning

Asynchronous learning is when communication between trainer and trainee do not occur simultaneously. I.N.D.I.A. TRUST propounds self-paced learning process, exchanging messages, either electronically or in person with mentors and trainers or by posting messages to a discussion group.

Authoring tools for asynchronous learning will be provided by I.N.D.I.A. TRUST.

Collaborative tools can sometime be provided to host moderated discussion group where students and instructors can collaborate on training related materials or assignments to facilitate asynchronous learning.

In addition, real time synchronous chat allows learners to communicate with their peers and instructors, emulating a physical classroom setting.

Content Management System

A unique content management system can be built for Chennai Schools using robust built in research capabilities. We will create information portals for Chennai Schools, which could serve as the foundation for the practice of Knowledge Management and to organize documents and media assets.
